

## Follow-up Calls for Patients tested for Covid-19:

### If No results:

1. Have you checked your temperature at least twice in the last 24 hrs? Is it 100.4 or higher?
2. Have you developed a new symptom or worsening of previous symptoms? If so, what is new or worsening?
3. Are still practicing social distancing/isolation?
4. Remind to practice good hygiene (hand washing for at least 20 seconds, use of hand sanitizer, covering cough with tissue or coughing into elbow)

### If Negative Result:

1. Notify patient that result is negative.
2. Remind to continue to practice good hygiene and practice social distancing because patient could still be exposed.
3. Contact their primary care provider for further recommendations concerning treatment of symptoms.

### If Positive Result (to be called by Physician or APP):

1. Notify patient that result is positive.
2. Notify patient that we will notify their primary care provider.
3. Patient needs to self-quarantine for 14 days from the day they were tested.
4. Patient needs to practice hygiene
5. Needs to present to EC if they have worsening of symptoms (shortness of breath, cough).
6. Remind patient that we will be checking on them daily.
